Supply List Wool Tile Tango



The class is suitable for all skill levels.

Finished block size: 8" x 8"

Learn how to make templates and a placement overlay, and how to fuse (or glue) and stitch wool applique shapes.

The block shown is not made from wool, but the design is very wool-friendly.

Shopping for wool:

I like the wool, wool thread, and glue stick from In The Patch. If you would like to shop wool and other supplies before class, you can find them online at www.pieceocake.com.

You can choose wool, cotton, cotton/linen, or linen for your background. It is a very good idea to prewash any non-wool fabrics before class. They will fuse better. It is not necessary to prewash felted wool.

Bring To Class

- Recommended book: Wool Appliqué the Piece O' Cake Way (for techniques), The Quilter's Practical Guide to Color (for the quilt pattern)
- Background fabric: Cut 1 square 10" x 10".

- Wool applique fabrics: A variety of scraps of felted wool in suitable colors. The 5" charm squares from In The Patch are a nice size to work with in class.
- Fusible web: 1 sheet of Soft Fuse OR 1/8 vard of 18"-wide fusible
- Non-stick pressing sheet
- If you don't want to fuse, bring 1 In The Patch glue stick instead of the fusible web and pressing sheet.
- A portable iron, pressing surface, and an extension cord if you are fusing. Note that you may not be able to use this in some classrooms.
- Applique threads: #12 perle cotton OR Wool Thread in colors to match or complement your fabrics. I will have some thread with me for you to use in class.
- Small paper scissors
- Small fabric scissors
- One 8" x 8" square of clear upholstery vinyl in a medium weight. Keep any tissue paper that might come with the vinyl.
- An ultra fine point Sharpie marker in black
- 1 Essential Laminating Sheet, available at at www.pieceocake.com OR clear, heavy weight, self-adhesive laminate available at some office supply stores. Get single-sided sheets, not pouches. I will have some individual sheets on sale in class.
- I will supply you with 2 needles and a toothpick.
- Applique pins. I recommend short pins.
- General's charcoal pencil in white.
- A Sewline or similar gray 9mm mechanical pencil for light fabrics
- A sandpaper board or a sheet of fine grain sandpaper.
- A baggie for your templates
- Many people find that applique is easier if they have a Lap App or pillow in their lap to rest their forearms on. You can find Lap Apps at pieceocake.com.
